

Keep the pressure on to **FREE MUMIA**

Mumia Abu-Jamal is an innocent man who has been on deathrow for 20 years. As a respected Philadelphia journalist Mumia was known as a voice for oppressed people and for exposing the cities' brutal police force. On December 9th, 1981 Mumia came upon the murder scene of a police officer, was shot, beaten and nearly killed by police and accused of murdering Officer Faulkner. He was railroaded through the courts and is still under the threat of being murdered by the State.

MUMIA IS INNOCENT! WE DEMAND HIS FREEDOM!

On Dec. 18th Judge Yohn threw out Mumia's death sentence but ignored all evidence of Mumia's innocence. DA Lynne Abraham has appealed Yohn's decision and currently Mumia remains on death row. As a result of Yohn's ruling there will be a new sentencing hearing (within 180 days) but not a new trial. With all of the evidence proving Mumia's innocence (including the confession of another man) Yohn should have released Mumia immediately. At the sentencing hearing no evidence will be introduced and the only choices will be life in prison or the death penalty. This is not acceptable. Mumia is innocent and we demand his freedom!

LIFE IN PRISON IS STILL A DEATH SENTENCE!!!

Now more than ever we need people to unite and join the movement to **free** Mumia. This system is trying to make people forget about Mumia and allow him to die in prison, innocent. Mumia is the evidence of how corrupt this system is, **NOT THE CRIME!**

When John Street was City Council president he met with members of ICFFMAJ (also present were Rodney Muhammed of the Nation of Islam, Bruce Trawley of the Chamber of Commerce and Mike Benjamin of the Black Barristers). At the meeting Street said that Mumia did not receive a fair trial, and that he would do what he could to make this happen. Since becoming Mayor he has done nothing. This is the same thing done by Wilson Goode, who before becoming mayor told MOVE that he believed MOVE prisoners were innocent. When Goode came into office, he did nothing to help MOVE people get out of prison. Instead on May 13th, 1985 he helped drop a bomb on the MOVE family murdering 6 adults and 5 children. The only adult survivor was jailed. Street's silence and broken promises in the case of Mumia mirror that of Goode and if Mumia dies the blood will be on his hands.
